HOW TO DO RIGHT WHEN YOU WANT TO DO WRONG?

There is a tension that all of us are born with. One part of us wants to do right, and the other part wants to do wrong. What is the Bible answer to this dilemma?

Directions: Read the Bible texts at the end of each statement, then circle TRUE or FALSE, or FILL IN THE BLANKS. **PRAY FIRST!**

1. Sin keeps us from doing right; and “sin is the _____ of the law.” (Romans 7:19-20; I John 3:4 KJV)
2. If we love Jesus we will not transgress/break His commandments. (John 14:15) **TRUE-FALSE**
3. Jesus knows that we need help to keep His commandments, so He promised to pray that His Father would send us the Comforter to help us. (John 14:16) **TRUE-FALSE**
4. The Comforter has other names, such as the: H___ G___ (John 14:26); S_____ of Truth (John 14:17); H___ Spirit (Luke 11:13); and the Spirit of G___ (Genesis 1:2; Matthew 3:16-17)
5. The Comforter teaches us all things; brings all that Jesus said to our remembrance; reproves us of sin, of righteousness, and of the judgment; guides us into all truth; shows us things to come; and glorifies Jesus. (John 14:26; 16:8, 13-14) **TRUE-FALSE**
6. When we rebel against the Holy Spirit, He is grieved. (Ephesians 4:30) **TRUE-FALSE**
7. Proof that we have the Holy Spirit is our obedience to God's Word, and having the fruit of the Spirit. (Acts 5:32; Galatians 5:22-23) **TRUE-FALSE**
8. The Comforter also gives us Spiritual Gifts according to His will. Therefore, He does not give everybody the same gift(s). (I Corinthians 12:8-11, 28-30) **TRUE-FALSE**
