## Lesson 5

### A CITY WITHOUT LAWS

We are living in a chaotic society where, in many cases, even the laws on the books are either ignored or unjustly administered. This is the results of a culture that believes that obedience to God's Ten Commandment Law is too restrictive and outdated. Hosea 8:7 describes our world's condition by saying, "For they sowed the wind and they shall reap the whirlwind."

**Directions:** Read the Bible texts at the end of each statement, then circle TRUE or FALSE, or FILL IN THE BLANKS. **PRAY FIRST!**

1. God's Ten Commandment Law, also referred to as tables of testimony, was written on two tables of stone by God Himself with His own finger. (Exodus 31:18; 32:16) **TRUE-FALSE**
2. We are not **j**\_\_\_\_\_ by keeping God's law. The law only gives us a knowledge of \_\_\_\_\_. (Romans 3:20 KJV).
3. The Ten Commandment Law was only for people in the Old Testament to obey; so Jesus came to destroy it. (Matthew 5:17-18) **TRUE-FALSE**
4. Lucifer sinned by coveting and bearing false witness against God; Adam and Eve sinned by coveting and stealing the fruit; and Cain sinned by killing Abel. Since none of these were Jews, is proof that the Ten Commandment Law was not given for only the Jews to keep. (Exodus 20:13, 15-17; I John 3:4 KJV) **TRUE-FALSE**
5. Children do not have to obey their parents today because Jesus nailed the Ten Commandment Law to the cross. (Exodus 20:12; Ephesians 6:1-3) **TRUE-FALSE**
6. The law that was abolished and nailed to the cross was not the Ten Commandment Law. It was the law of ordinances pertaining to the Old Testament ceremonial system of animal sacrifices. The lambs and other animals symbolized Jesus the Lamb of God who would come and die for the sins of the world. (Ephesians 2:15; Colossians 2:9-17; John 1:29 KJV) **TRUE-FALSE**
7. Jesus said, "If you love Me keep My **command**\_\_\_\_\_." "...I have kept My Father's **command**\_\_\_\_\_ and abide in His love." (John 14:15; John 15:10)
8. Although Christians are not under the condemnation of the law, and do not keep the law to earn salvation, because salvation is a gift from God based upon His grace and our faith in Jesus' death for our sins; Christians still must obey the law. (Romans 6:14-15; Titus 3:5-7; Ephesians 2:8-9) **TRUE-FALSE**
