## A CITY OF LOVE

The Bible speaks of a city of love that God promised to His people as far back as the time of the patriarch Abraham. And ever since that time, all of God's people have had hopes of living in that city. The Good News is that we are closer to the fulfillment of that promise than we have ever been!

**Directions:** Read the Bible texts at the end of each statement, then circle TRUE or FALSE, or FILL IN THE BLANKS. **PRAY FIRST!**

1. This is what the Bible says about Abraham, "For he looked for a \_ \_ \_ which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is \_ \_ \_." (Hebrews 11:8-10)
2. When Jesus was about to leave this earth to return to heaven, He made a promise to His disciples concerning that heavenly city that Abraham looked for. (John 14:1-3) **TRUE-FALSE**
3. When Jesus returns to this earth, He is going to destroy it with fire because it is polluted by sin. He will establish a new earth without sin. (II Peter 3:10-13; Revelation 21:1-2) **TRUE-FALSE**  
NOTE: According to II Corinthians 12:2-4 there are three heavens. The first heaven is the aerial heaven where birds and airplanes fly. The second heaven is the stellar heaven where the sun, moon, stars and planets are. The third heaven is Paradise, where God's throne is. The first and second heavens are polluted by sin, and will be destroyed when Jesus returns.
