DON'T BE AFRAID OF THE JUDGMENT

Every human being that has ever lived on planet earth has a case pending before the Supreme Court of the Universe. And as frightening as this seems to be, the GOOD NEWS is we don't have to be afraid of the Judgment if we know the JUDGE. God will vindicate Himself and His people of all accusations made against Him and them by Satan and his followers, in the Judgment.
