FREEDOM IN CHRIST!

In John 8:36, Jesus said, “If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.” There are four areas in which Jesus makes us free when we accept Him as our Lord and Savior. He makes us free from His **Wrath**; from **Sin**; from **the Condemnation of the Law**; and from **Death**.

Directions: Read the Bible texts at the end of each statement, then circle TRUE or FALSE, or FILL IN THE BLANKS. **PRAY FIRST!**

1. A day of wrath is coming when God will render to the unrighteous according to their deeds. (Romans 2:5-6, 8) **TRUE-FALSE**
2. What is going to happen to those who are justified and reconciled to God by accepting Jesus? (Romans 5:6-10) ans. They shall be “s_ _ _ _ from wrath through Him [Jesus].”
3. Instead of fearing God’s wrath, we can have “p_ _ _ _ with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.” (Romans 5:1-2)
4. In order for Jesus to set us free from sin, we must be willing to die to sin, which is what the Ordinance of Baptism symbolizes. (Romans 6:1-5; 1 Cor. 15:31; Gal. 2:20; 2 Cor. 5:17) **TRUE-FALSE**
5. The Ordinance of Baptism also commemorates the d _ _ _ _ , b _ _ _ _ _ , and r _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ of Jesus. (Romans 6:3-5)
6. Before we accept Jesus, sin is like a ruler or a master that has dominion over us. Therefore, we do whatever sin commands us to do. (Romans 6:16) **TRUE-FALSE**
7. What happens when Jesus sets us free from sin? (Romans 6:22) “But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your f _ _ _ _ unto h _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ , and the end e _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ 1 _ _ _ .”
8. We would not know what sin is without the law (Ten Commandments). Therefore, there is nothing wrong with the law. (Romans 7:7, 12; 5:13; I John 3:4) **TRUE-FALSE**
9. When we break the law we sin, and the law condemns us. But when we accept Jesus and die to sin, the law stops condemning us. Therefore, Jesus sets us free from the CONDEMNATION OF THE LAW, but not from the obligation to keep the law. (Romans 7:1, 7-12; John 14:15) **TRUE-FALSE**

10. What is the last enemy that Jesus shall destroy? (I Corinthians 15:26) ans. D _ _ _ _
11. Those who accept Jesus will be set free from death by Jesus' Spirit. (Rom. 8:11, 13; I Corinthians 15:52, 54; Rev. 21:4) **TRUE-FALSE**
12. Is it your desire to accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior and have freedom from God's wrath, sin, the condemnation of the law, and death; and do you want the courage to not let anything separate you from the love of God and Jesus Christ our Lord? (Romans 8:31-39) ___**YES**
